

Applying

Application for admission and financial aid must be received in the Entomology Department by December 1 for the following year's fall semester. Students are not ordinarily admitted for the spring semester. There is an application fee of \$50. Original general test scores on the Graduate Record Examination are required as part of the application documentation as is the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) for international applicants.

Application for graduate study in Entomology at the University of Arizona is a two-step process:

1. Admission Requirements to be sent to Graduate Admissions online
 1. Submit the online Graduate College Application Form and \$50.00 application fee at:

 2. For all applicants, have your scores on the GRE General Test sent to the University of Arizona (GRE Code: R4832)
 3. For applicants from countries in which English is not the official language, have your scores on the TOEFL exam sent to the University of Arizona (TOEFL Code: 4832). 3. Original transcripts from all colleges and universities attended
4. Three original letters of recommendation from faculty, supervisors, or professional mentors
5. Your Curriculum Vitae or resume
6. A 1- to 2-page statement of interest explaining your reasons for attending graduate school, research interests, and professional goals
7. DEADLINES: Admission materials must be **received** at the University of Arizona by the following dates, for admission the following August:
 - International applicants: December 1
 - U.S.A. citizens or permanent residents: January 1
