

Macromedia Breeze

What is it?

Macromedia Breeze is an integrated web communication solution for real-time meetings, eLearning, and online presentations that audiences can see and hear anytime, anywhere, through any standard web browser.

Who may use it?

Breeze is a free¹ service to any University of Arizona employee. Any employee may set-up and host a Breeze meeting. Non-university people may participate in a meeting.

How do I get started?

In order to host a breeze meeting you must have a Breeze server account. Go to <http://www.ltc.arizona.edu/srfs20/> to request a Breeze account. You will need your UA net id and password. You will be sent a userid and password and instructions. Also see Breeze Host Instructions at <http://cals.arizona.edu/extension/employee/breeze.html>.

What equipment do I need?

Speakers for your computer are required and a microphone is highly recommended. Webcams may also be used for live video, however, they require a higher Internet connection speed. Extension Administration will provide Logitech microphones to county offices, EIRP offices, and Experiment Station offices. If you need more equipment we suggest you purchase from the following:

- Logitech QuickCam Orbit MP
- Logitech Premium USB Headset 350
- Logitech USB Desktop Microphone

We realize that there may be less expensive equipment available, but computer support staff has tested many different set-up and feel these work the best. Support staff is also familiar with this equipment to assist with troubleshooting.
