CODE OF CONDUCT

The mission of Arizona 4-H Youth Development is to provide a variety of educational opportunities which will assist youth to become capable and contributing members of our global society. In fulfilling this mission, certain standards of behavior are expected of all participants and is also necessary to provide a positive learning environment for others. The following guidelines represent the Arizona 4-H Youth Development CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. Work cooperatively with other 4-H participants, youth, volunteer leaders, families, Cooperative Extension faculty and staff and others, in a courteous, respectful manner.
2. Make every attempt to actively involve all participants in group activities.
3. Represent the Arizona 4-H Youth Development Program with pride and dignity.
4. Obey the laws of the locality, state, and nation. Know that the use of tobacco, alcohol, and illegal drugs/substances is prohibited at all 4-H events.
5. Dress appropriately for all 4-H events. Your appearance and action during all 4-H events should be a positive influence to others.
6. Use language and display manners that will bring respect to you and the Arizona 4-H Youth Development program. You are responsible to know what language and behavior are appropriate.
7. Treat program areas, lodging areas, and transportation vehicles with respect and care. You will be responsible for any damage, theft, or misconduct in which you participate.
8. Attend all sessions in the planned program. If you are not feeling well or have a schedule conflict that would keep you from attending, please report to the appropriate adult in charge.
9. Follow hours and room rules established before the event begins. You are responsible to know the rules for each event.
10. Live up to your highest expectations for yourself, so you can return home proud of who you are and what you have done.

Those who find themselves unable to conduct themselves within the guidelines listed above may expect:

1. To explain their actions to those in charge
2. To accept the consequences of their actions
3. To have those in charge work closely with parents/guardians, Extension personnel, and affected others to see that actions taken, in case of unacceptable behavior, appropriate and logical consequences for all concerned.
4. If the child does not behave in an appropriate manner, he/she may be sent home at the expense of the parents/guardians.
