

# ANIMAL INFORMATION

- 1. It is your responsibility to understand the requirements and expectations found on your enrollment sheet and the fair book!!!
- 2. Basic information for animal projects

Beef- Ownership Deadline- **TBD**  
 Suggested starting weight is 800 pounds. Beef should be no more than 18 months old at fair and weigh at least 1,000 pounds. Youth must be able to able and control the steer alone with one lead rope at the time of fair or the will be sifted. Suggested weight at fair time is 1,250 pounds.

All other animals- Ownership Deadline- **TBD**

Swine- Swine not meeting the required 210-275 weight limit will be sifted.  
 Suggested weight at fair time is 250 pounds.

Lamb- All breeds must weigh at least 100 pounds and not have their yearling tooth visible at the fair.

Goat- Must be dehorned and less that 1 year old at fair time.

Rabbits- Must provide pedigree with ownership forms. Check with rabbit leader or Extension Agent for more detailed information.
