A replacement animal could be purchased upon filing and acceptance of this form. All animal ownership deadlines will apply in accordance with La Paz Youth Livestock Regulations. (see below)

La Paz Youth Livestock Committee Rules and Regulations

Livestock projects must be owned and ear-tagged according to 4-H rules and regulations or the animal will not be allowed at the fair. In the event that an animal dies due to accident or illness during the time between ownership deadline and 60 days before the day of fair animal entry day, an exhibitor can get a replacement animal upon filing and acceptance of this form by the 4-H agent and the Youth Livestock Committee. Forms must be submitted with 5 days of the loss of the animal. The La Paz Youth Livestock Committee will have final discretion on allowing hardship replacement animals.
