

# La Paz 4-H Requirements To Complete The 4-H year

Adopted 9/9/02 by La Paz 4-H Council and the 4-H Office

## Requirements to complete the 4-H year

All 4-H members are required to meet the following standards each year. Your club may have additional requirements and will notify the youth members by the 1<sup>st</sup> 4-H meeting of the year.

- Adhere to the expectations of the responsibility form attached to the youth enrollment sheet.
- Attend at least 70 percent of regular club meetings and/or activities.
- Complete a 4-H project, doing one's own work with minimal assistance from parents or others.
- Give a club or county 4-H public presentation.
- Complete a project record book and turn it in to your Community Club Leader.
- If adequate record books are not submitted, the youth will not be allowed to show a 4-H project animal at the following La Paz County Fair.
- Participate in 4 recognized county events throughout the year. 2 of those county events must be attended before Fair Set Up Day. If the youth does not meet this requirement, s/he will not be eligible to auction an animal at the fair the following year.

**All project-related clinics attended throughout the year will count as a county event. Including Leader/Officer trainings.**

### **Leaders**

All **4-H projects** are expected to hold at least 5 meetings before the fair, and 2 after the fair. One of these meetings can be the recordbook workshop held in coordination with the community club.
