Any medication given for the health of the animal to treat a disease or infection with-in 30 days prior to being received at the fair must be declared to the Extension Office within 10 days of the first dose of medication. An animal must be healthy upon arrival and weigh in at the fair and be accompanied by a clean bill of health by a licenced veterinarian. Treated animals may be shown.
