At the Dec. 2006 ACE Health Coalition meeting, several folks noted that the "spray jockey" figure so common on postings for pesticide applications is an out of date icon that misrepresents IPM efforts. Is it required? NO! Furthermore, UA school IPM program staff followed up by working with SPCC staff Vince Craig and Mike Francis to create the attached form for pesticide application postings. If completely and correctly filled out, this form meets state law requirements for:

- ✓ Pre-notification of pesticide applications
- ✓ Post-application notifications (as in the case of emergency applications)
