Subject: Dicrotophos (Bidrin) Registration Review

Good Afternoon,

The registration review preliminary risk assessments for dicrotophos are scheduled to publish on July 30th for a 60 day comment period. They will be available in the dicrotophos registration review docket (EPA-HQ-2008-0440) on www.regulations.gov. The intent of this message is to alert you about the opening of the comment period and also to provide a heads-up about specific information needs we are identifying in the Federal Register Notice that would help the Agency as it continues the registration review of dicrotophos. EPA is specifically looking for additional information on the following: existing or planned water quality monitoring data, where aerial application of dicrotophos is important, and suggestions for risk mitigation measures that address the risks identified in the draft human health and ecological risk assessments for dicrotophos.

Additionally, I am going on a temporary reassignment in a different part of EPA beginning August 11th. Melissa Grable is the acting team leader for dicrotophos and she will be able to direct any questions you may have to my replacement (once that person is decided upon).
