Abstract Format for all Papers and Posters

Submission Guidelines

Contributed papers and conference presentations should be prepared as MS Word files in 12 point, Times New Roman font, left justified only, and include all of the following:

1. A brief but descriptive title at the top of the page.
2. A list of all author(s) and affiliation, complete mailing address, telephone number, fax number, and e-mail address.
3. An abstract of 250 words (submit as text- do not include tables, figures, footnotes or references in the abstract).
4. Clear indication of preference for a poster, peer-reviewed paper for the conference proceedings or both.
5. If a poster, specify size.
6. Clear indication if you would like to be considered as a conference speaker.
7. Submit an electronic version of the abstract to: tsprouse@ag.arizona.edu.
