

## RCSC SUMMER INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

**NOTE: A maximum of 9 units of RCSC internship coursework may be used as RCSC electives. RCSC students must also complete a minimum of 9 units of non-experiential RCSC upper-division elective coursework to fulfill their RCSC degree requirements.**

Course Number	Units	Requirements	Eligibility	Description of Experience
RCSC 293	3 units	45 hours per unit plus additional work as determined by RCSC internship coordinator	<b>RCSC Majors only that have progressed into the RCSC Major but have not taken any upper division RCSC courses. Available Summer Session II only.</b>	This internship will be primarily at an entry level such as a store internship. This minimum five-week course requires the following: weekly logs and a final comprehensive paper. Internship must be pre-approved by the Internship Coordinator to earn RCSC credits. Grading: S, P, C, D, E
RCSC 393	3 or 6 units	45 hours per unit plus additional work as determined by RCSC internship coordinator	<b>RCSC majors only that graduate in August and have completed RCSC 304 and RCSC 384.</b>	This internship will end in July with the conclusion of Summer Session I. This minimum five week course requires the following: weekly logs and interviews, a project, along with a final comprehensive paper. Must be pre-approved by the RCSC internship coordinator. Grading: S, P, C, D, E
RCSC 493B	3, 6, or 9 units	45 hours per unit plus additional work as determined by RCSC internship coordinator	<b>RCSC majors only that have completed RCSC 304 and RCSC 384.</b>	This internship will run 8-10 weeks over the summer. Students will be required to present an overview of their internship to a RCSC class or at a RCSC Information Session in the fall semester. Weekly logs and interviews are required along with a final comprehensive paper. Must be pre-approved by the RCSC internship coordinator. Grading: S, P, C, D, E
